

INSTALLATION

*FOR PRESSURES EXCEEDING 500kPa INSTALL A PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE. THOROUGHLY FLUSH ALL PIPES TO ELIMINATE ANY REMAINING DIRT AND RESIDUE, AND INSTALL INLINE FILTERS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY VOID THE WARRANTY.

- Position tap in **35mm** hole, making sure the Rubber seal (1) between mixer and bench is fitted within base-ring.
- Anchor to bench with underbench C-Clamp (4). The flat rubber gasket (2) should be against bench, followed by flat metal C-Washer (3), then C-Clamp. Screws on the C-Clamp can be tightened to firmly affix mixer to bench.
- Thoroughly flush all water pipes to eliminate any remaining dirt and residue and install inline filters.
- Attach Hot & Cold Flexihoses (6 & 7) to wall connections or filter stops. Maximum bend for flexible hose is
 35mm radius. Do not stretch, crush or twist hoses. Do not swage hose ends. Do not overtighten flexihose nuts.
- Push the Pull-down hose connection (8) into Fast-fit Connection (9), ensuring an audible click is heard.
- Ensure handpiece is fully retracted into holder, then attach underbench hose weight (10) to pull-down hose (11) at least 50mm above bottom of looped hose.
- Check that there are no obstructions to the hose or weight when pulling handpiece in and out and that the hose is not twisted.



- The hose should not be wrapping around the flexihoses, or other underbench hoses or pipework.
- Turn on mains supply.
- Check for leaks, and for correct operation of multifunction handpiece.

Plumbers Note: Do not pressure test this mixer under static pressure.


CARE AND MAINTENANCE
