INSTALLATION

*FOR PRESSURES EXCEEDING 500kPa INSTALL A PRESSURE REDUCING VALVE. THOROUGHLY FLUSH ALL PIPES TO ELIMINATE ANY REMAINING DIRT AND RESIDUE AND INSTALL INLINE FILTERS. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY VOID THE WARRANTY.

- Before commencing installation, turn off the water supply.
- Cut a 30mm hole in wall lining for each tap body and a 24mm hole for the spout spigot.
- Remove handles and flanges/collar trim. Fit manifold to wall recess max depth 45mm from outside of finished wall lining including tiles ensure enough thread will extend from finished wall lining for attaching flange/collar trim (minimum 19mm).
- Firmly affix all three brackets (i.e. tap bodies + spout tee) with appropriate screws.
- Connect inlets to plumbing with either Crox or compression fittings. NB: Do not braize inlet/outlet joints. Under no circumstances should the inlet and/or outlet joints be welded.
- Once wall lining is installed, cut ½" threaded tube to length, allowing for a minimum 10mm thread protrusion.

ATTACH PROOF OF PURCHASE HERE

- Fit spout, flanges and handles (items 7, 3 & 2), then fit H and C indicators onto handles.
- Turn on the water supply and check for leaks.
